The Blessedness of Meekness

Matthew 5:5 “Blessed are the meek: for they shall inherit the earth.”

Jesus said that it’s a blessing to be meek. What does it mean to ‘be meek’?

Think of the things that bring agitation and anger and upset into our souls. Wouldn’t a spirit of meekness take care of most of them? Don’t most of them come from some violation of our perceived “rights”? What are some of the “rights” that we think we have that lead us to anger when someone violates them?

In Matt. 11:28-30, Jesus makes a wonderful appeal to all who are tired and overburdened in their souls to come and learn from Him the easy and light way. What were the two qualities about Himself that He said would give us rest in our souls?

How did Jesus demonstrate meekness? What rights did He give up? _____

Another way of saying “inherit the earth” is to “possess the land”. How does having a meek spirit enable us to “possess the land” in our lives?
