### Your Kingdom Come!

**Matthew 6:10a** “Thy Kingdom come...”

In our first two lessons on the Lord’s Prayer we saw: **1-** that the focus of our prayers is not to be on ourselves, but rather on our Father, and **2-** that our first petition and desire should be that His name would be praised on earth. Jesus continues this God-centered focus by instructing us to make our second petition to be that His Kingdom would come. WE understand that Jesus told us to pray “after this manner” or “pattern” not just using the words “Thy Kingdom come”, but wanting the desire, burden and focus in our prayers to be on His Kingdom purposes.

In order to understand what this “Thy Kingdom come” pattern looks like, we need to consider what a “kingdom” is. The word “kingdom” is a combination of two words: “king” and “domain”. A “kingdom” is the territory where the king has the domain or rule. Thus **the Kingdom of God is wherever God is the ruler!**

What does the simple fact that we need to pray for His Kingdom to come reveal to us? Why does His Kingdom need to come? \_\_\_\_\_

What insight can we get from the following Scriptures as to what we’re asking for when we pray “Thy Kingdom come”?

What is the promise given in Luke 12:29-31 for those who put God’s Kingdom first? \_\_\_\_\_

Isaiah 9:7 says of the Kingdom of Christ that the increase of its government shall have no end; in other words, the domain that He rules over is getting more and more massive with the passing of each day in history. We get to be a part of that process as we pray “Thy Kingdom come” and as we live for the King ourselves!

#### Am I a “Disciple InDeed”?

1. Do I have a burden that the domain of Christ would increase in my life and in the world around me?
2. Do my prayers sound like a servant coming to his Lord for direction and provision to do His bidding, or are they more like someone who has his own agenda and wants help in accomplishing it?
3. Am I opening my heart more and more to let Christ be the Ruler of every area or do I keep back certain areas that I don’t want Him to change?
