### God's Servants Shall Not Lack

**Matthew 6:31-33** “Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed? (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things. But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.”

1. Knowing how prone we are to worry, Jesus repeats the command from our last lesson to “take no (anxious) thought” for how we’re going to keep ourselves alive and clothes on our bodies! When Jesus said, “for after all these things do the Gentiles seek”, what was He wanting us to see and realize about these attitudes?
