Only Doers Will Enter

Matthew 7:21-23 “Not every one that saith unto me, Lord, Lord, shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven. Many will say to me in that day, Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in thy name? and in thy name have cast out devils? and in thy name done many wonderful works? And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.”

1. Jesus says that simply calling Him “Lord” doesn’t make one fit for the Kingdom; neither do preaching, casting out devils, or doing wonderful works in His name! What was the one criteria that He said will demonstrate that one is fit for entry into the Kingdom of Heaven?
