4177 - The Cry of God's Heart (Denny Kenaston)

What is the cry of God's heart? Bro. Denny uses Isaiah 6 and John 3:16 to show us that God is seeking to save the lost. We see it in the Old Testament and we see it in the atonement. Do you wonder if you are hearing the cry of God? In this message, Bro. Denny will challenge you to see God's heart for the lost.
